Denville P.A.L. Basketball Gym Usage Rules and Code of Conduct Applies to Coaches, Players, Parents, and ALL Spectators

Players and Parents Must sign and turn in before or at first practice

Our coaches do an outstanding job of teaching our children and advocating a proper atmosphere at both practices and games. However, occasionally problems may arise at the various gyms used by our league during games. These problems may include unruly children, overzealous adults, fights, vandalism or even "911" false alarms. These incidents are largely caused by the families and friends of our young athletes, who are supposed to be watching the games.

Parents are reminded that <u>they</u> are responsible for overseeing their children that aren't playing and the behavior of any family or friends they bring into the gyms, NOT the coaches, referees, or town directors. Parents will be financially responsible for any damage that their children, family members or friends cause. Also, the Custodians and league members have been advised to monitor the hallways, they are to be treated with RESPECT. It is the parents' responsibility to always supervise their children and ALL adults and children must adhere to the following rules:

- No roaming or playing in the hallways, stage, or any other area of the schools
- No destroying school property.... EVER
- No utilizing school equipment or apparatuses without permission
- No profanity
- No derogatory remarks toward the referees, players, or coaches
- No littering
- No smoking in the building
- Be sportsmanlike or positive while cheering for your team.
- No skateboarding in the gyms.
- No loitering around in the gym or school at the completion of the day's games

The League Directors or Referees have the right to remove anyone from the gym at his/her discretion if rules are violated. Repeat offenders are subject to expulsion from the league. Games will be stopped if anyone is not cooperative with these decisions and if necessary, the police will be called.
